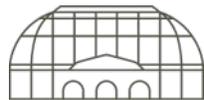

CETAF ISTC Meeting March 2015

- ▶ Simon Chagnoux presented “Les Herbonautes”
 - ▶ web-based software platform
 - ▶ for crowdsourcing of herbarium label transcriptions developed
 - ▶ the system was up and running (=> ready to use)
 - ▶ the language configuration has been decoupled from the software code
 - ▶ it was agreed that the ISTC will not start a new initiative or sub-group for activities related to crowdsourcing of label transcriptions
- ⇒ However, several ISTC-members expressed their strong interest to test the software for their transcription activities
- ⇒ Paris will provide the software (open source) as well as the necessary technical background information on request
